Eaton Bray Cricket Club was formed on 2nd April 1914 at the Coffee Tavern Reading Rooms. Like many things in the village at that time the benefactor was WH Wallace who is said to have put up the initial money for equipment. It was not a good year all round in 1914 and the team folded after two seasons due to circumstances in Europe taking some of their players. At the winding up meeting on October 26th 1915 the financial report had them in debt by 16s 9d owed to WH Wallace.

The Recent Years started on 13 June 1981 with the first game on The Rye Gardens, the new ground. The actual start was delayed by two weeks as the planned start, against Edlesborough, was rained-off. The first opposition was Stoke Hammond. A game which ended in defeat by 62 runs, but fittingly, two of the club's finest cricketers; Barry Meakins and Eric Pratt took the first wicket and scored Eaton Bray's first run.

Prior to playing at The Rye Gardens, the club played its home games on the park at the end of The Rye, with the wicket placed in the centre circle of the football pitch. As the football season extended, it became impossible to prepare a safe wicket and outfield in time, despite the effort of the then President, George French and his willing

helpers. Ken Bearton, the Chairman, and members took the decision to find an alternative ground in 1978

A piece of land was found within the year, and prior to its conversion to a cricket ground, The Rye Gardens was a former allotment site. The club obtained permission from the Parish Council, its owner and from Ministry of Environment for the loss of this type of local amenity. However the County Council were initially less supportive, and its officers suggested an alternative site on the corner of Totternhoe Road and Stanbridge Road. The development of nursery site, in the centre of the village, was even mentioned as a future home to the cricket club. The club finally secured The Rye Gardens on the understanding that

the club could be further relocated if and when the Parish Council provided a comparable ground and facilities.

So whilst the first game was in the middle of 1981, the planning, preparation and fund raising took almost 3½ years. Indeed the fund-raising continued for many years after the move. The cost of the initial, very basic infrastructure amounted to £1680, yet the club had only £90.41 in 1979. Fund raising events were arranged, grants applied for, and annual subscriptions were introduced for the first time, at £5 per member. The club kept costs low by doing work themselves, such as painting the pavilion and destoning the outfield, plus important drainage media to the wicket was excluded as it was considered too expensive. Builder Brian Scott was however adamant that costs should not be cut with the toilet facilities!

One year after moving to The Rye Gardens, the club helped form the Beds and Bucks Border League. This was a league of 10

local clubs that already played friendly fixtures. The introduction of a league sought to add further competition to the existing games. Although the club was runners-up in the second season, it was largely unsuccessful for the first 16 years. Captains Larry Ryan and Mick Flecknell however changed the fortunes of the club, laying the foundations for seven Division 1 titles between 1998 and 2008. By 2008 the original league had increased in size and merged with another league and evolved into the Four Counties League, one of six divisions. By this time the club, along with many others, were fielding two league teams on a Saturday.

Since 1981 the rudimentary facilities of pavilion and ground have been steadily improved. The ex Wimpey site office (pavilion) was extended in 1989 to house three showers. For eight years the players had to rely only on the great smell of Brut! Two sight screens, boundary rope, score box, lock-up, bar and a veranda were all added through the years, as were neighbouring properties, either side of the ground. The wicket and outfield has improved too, with local help and support. Perhaps the most significant development of the club in the Recent Years was the formation of a Junior section in 2011. Since then, a lot of investment has been made by the club's coaching staff to develop and encourage juniors into enjoying cricket and playing for Eaton Bray Cricket Club.

- Please do all you can to keep the ground and pavilion tidy, particularly after net sessions.

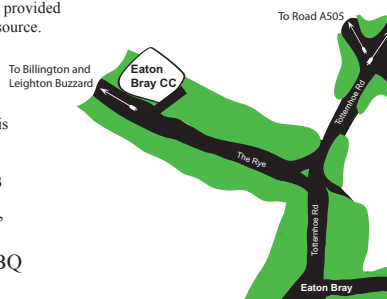
